Multicultural Association Hosting Human Rights Day Conversation Café

Fort McMurray, AB / November 19, 2024 - In recognition of Human Rights Day, the Multicultural Association of Wood Buffalo (MCA) will host its annual Human Rights Day Conversation Café on **Sunday, December 1, 2024**. The event invites the community to join a meaningful dialogue between local community leaders as they explore this year's theme, *"The Right to Physical and Mental Health."*

The event will take place from **12 pm to 3 pm at the Elements Dining Room - Keyano College** (8115 Franklin Avenue), starting with lunch, followed by a panel discussion where community panelists will share insights, experiences, and ideas on advancing human rights in our region. This conversation aims to engage local voices in discussing essential rights and freedoms, contributing to a more inclusive future for all.

Human Rights Day, observed annually on December 10, commemorates the adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights in 1948, a historic document proclaiming the rights to which every person is entitled, regardless of background. The MCA's Human Rights Day Conversation Café brings community members together to reflect on these rights and their impact on Wood Buffalo.
